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10 TIPS on Countering Bullying

1 Take Conflicts Seriously Before Escalation

Harmful behavior from a party in a conflict should be immediately stopped.

2 Take Bullying Reports Very Seriously

One should always step in and provide help, especially when a student asks for it.

3 Have Teachers Be Proactive

Teachers should be ready to intervene and be diligent.

4 Educate the Bully on His/Her Behavior

Kindly but firmly explain to the bully that their behavior is not acceptable.

5 Support Those Getting Bullied

Listen, advise, and support the victim. Help build their confidence.

6 Hold Counseling for All Parties

Trained professionals should provide counseling to victims and bullies.

7 Deal Effectively With the Bully

Have the bully make amends for any wrong. Constructive consequence should be given to the student.

8 Encourage Kids to Share Their Experiences With a Trusted Adult

Remind them that you are there to help and not judge.

9 Parents Should Address Concerns Immediately

Contact school administration to take appropriate action if your child is bullied.

10 Get Intervention From Other Sources

Call the police in severe cases of assault, extortion, or hate crimes
